
## GJP Goals and Theory of Change

## Desistance Research:

The Effect of Time With No New Arrests

#### Rearrest or Recidivism:

Most occurs within 3 years of an initial charge

Virtually all occurs within 5 years



5 years after initial arrest, if no other arrests:

Risk of arrest is the same as the general public




Have a Job?

2 times as likely to avoid rearrest

### OPPORTUNITY: Benefits and Bottom Line



- Eager to Work
  - Unemployment rate 5x general rate
  - 64% of unemployed men have at least an arrest record
- Better Retention, Less Turnover
  - John Hopkins study



- More Motivation & More Loyalty
  - Employers like Butterball Farms observed employees with records are more highly motivated and loyal
  - Harvard Military Study

### **2050 PROJECTIONS**


- By 2050, there is an expected 46% growth in jobs statewide.
  - This is creation of more than 3.1 million jobs.
- By 2050, Georgia's population is projected grow by 22.6%.
- This is an increase of nearly 2.5 million individuals.



## 89% of companies have either already taken action to win "the war for talent" or are planning to do so in the future, with many focused on compensation and flexibility.

73% of CEOs have already or are planning to increase compensation to recruit and retain employees.
